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7.0 SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (PART I)

- 7.1 **BID BOND:** Tenderers are requested to submit bid bond of Rs. 112,000/- in the form of Demand Draft to be issued by any scheduled bank in Sri Lanka in favour of Lanka IOC PLC and payable at Lanka IOC PLC, Trincomalee Oil Terminal, Chinabay, Trincomalee.

The Bid Bond of the unsuccessful Bidders shall be released only after the tender is finalized. The bid bond of the successful bidders will be released only after the satisfactory removal of the items with in the stipulated time period. **Bid bond shall not carry any interest.** Tenders received without bid bond shall be rejected outright.

- 7.2 **The tender is a percentage tender with the base rate of Rs. 45.70 per KG excluding VAT/NBT. Bidders are requested to quote only plus (+) percentage above base rate. In case of identical H1 rates quoted by two or more bidders, the bidder with highest average financial turnover in the last three years shall take precedence in overall ranking. Bids received with minus (-) percentage shall be summarily rejected.** The Offers are to be quoted exclusive of Taxes/Duties. However, taxes are applicable as per government policy as on date of sale. The Material projected for sale strictly on '**AS IS WHERE IS**' and '**No Complaint Basis**'.
The successful bidder has to make initial deposit of Rs. 5 Million and balance during the upliftment of scrap as per weight basis.

- 7.3 **INSPECTION OF MATERIAL:** The interested bidders may inspect the material at Lanka IOC PLC, Chinabay, Trincomalee within working days **from 0800 hrs to 1630 hrs (Excluding Saturday, Sunday and holidays)** before tender submission/closing date.

- 7.4 **SALE IS ON AS IS WHERE BASIS IS:** The sale will be on '**AS IS WHERE IS BASIS**'. It is the responsibility of the TENDERER to inspect the material during working hours on working days before bidding. Description (specification, quality, size. etc.) of the material is only indicative and quantity is approximate and the use of such description shall not constitute the sale thereof to be sold by description and no sale shall be invalid by reason of any defect in any tender or on account of any tender incorrectly described and or on account of weight of any tender sold by weight being incorrectly stated and the purchaser shall not be entitled to claim any damage or compensation whatsoever on account of such defect in description or weight. Weighment at OWNERS (LIOC), Weigh Bridge shall be final and binding for the materials sold by weight. Should the quantity on actual count, weight or measurement as the case may be works out less than the quantity tendered/indicated in the sale order, OWNERS(LIOC), will not under any circumstances be liable to make good the same deficiency, but proportionate refund shall be made to the purchaser. No pick and choose of the material will be allowed and the purchaser has to lift the entire tender from the designated place.

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- 7.5 **VAT/TAXES & DUTIES:** Excise Duty, VAT and any other taxes and duties or levies as Applicable on the date of delivery will be charged extra.
- 7.6 **STATUTORY PAYMENTS:** The rate of VAT & Duties, etc., will be applicable as on date of delivery of material.
- 7.7 **REMOVAL OF MATERIAL:** For lifting /removal of the materials, Purchaser has to make his/their own arrangement for loading and transportation and the seller (LIOC) will not take responsibility for providing any assistance to the Purchaser in this regard. In this regard, lifting/removal will be allowed only on working days and during normal working hours. As per LIOC Officer Instructions, Scarp materials have to be lifted from the scrap yard/tank farm / other places as per shown during uplifting. No HOT work is entertained while removal of scrap materials without LIOC permission.
- 7.8 **FACTORY RULES & PROCEDURE:** The Purchaser shall abide by all the rules and procedure of safety and security of Seller's factory (LIOC) and comply with relevant provisions of workmen compensation Act and any other statute in respect of persons engaged by him for handling of materials inside the Factory premises and indemnify the seller against any claim from any one in execution of the order.
- 7.9 **LOSS OR DAMAGE OF SELLER'S PROPERTY:** The purchaser shall be responsible for making good any loss or damage caused to the property of seller due to negligence or persons engaged by him/them.

- 7.10 Tenderers may note that the bid bond shall be forfeited in case of following situations:
- Canvassing of information or submission of forged/ false documents/ information by tenderers.
 - Unilateral withdrawal or revision of the offer by the tenderer during the validity period of the offer.
 - Backing out after placement of work order.
- 7.11 **COMPLETION PERIOD:** The tenderers must note that all the scrapped pipes, valves and miscellaneous scrap must be uplifted from the Chinabay Terminal, Trincomalee within a maximum duration of 6 (SIX) Weeks from the date of placement of work order after depositing the quoted amount plus all applicable taxes in the form of demand draft to the office of LIOC at Trincomalee.

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7.12 VALIDITY OF TENDER:

The tender will be valid for a period of **120 days** from the date of opening. The price bid format is in Tender form for “Disposal of scrapped pipes, valves and miscellaneous scrap” in “as is where is” condition at Lanka IOC PLC, Trincomalee Terminal, China Bay.

Bidders are requested to inspect the scrapped pipes, valves and miscellaneous scrap at our Terminal and satisfy themselves with regard to the present condition of these items prior to submitting their quotes, as no arguments whatsoever in this regard will be entertained after submission of the bid by the party.

All charges for transportation, handling & removal including dismantling / Loading etc. of these materials from LIOC premises including labour / Machinery / Transport etc. shall be borne by successful bidder.

It must be noted that the orders shall be placed on the bidder who has quoted highest rate for the disposal of scrapped items.

- 7.13 All offers should be legible written / typed in the space provided in the attached schedule and submitted along with the annexed declaration form duly signed by the bidder.
- 7.14 All rates given in tender schedule would be expressed both in words and figures and where there is difference between the two; rates given in words shall be taken as authentic.
- 7.15 Sealed tenders should be deposited in the tender box provided only at the office of the **Sr.Vice President (Ops. & LBP), Lanka IOC PLC, Trincomalee Oil Terminal, Trincomalee** or sent by registered post to reach us **on or before 15:00 Hrs on 31st October 2019**. The top left hand corner of the envelope containing the quote should be marked “Disposal of Scrapped pipes, valves and miscellaneous scrap from Lanka IOC PLC, Trincomalee Terminal, Chinabay, Tender No and Due date & Time”. The Corporation will not accept any responsibility and the tenderer will be solely responsible for depositing the tender in time in the tender box.
- 7.16 Tenders shall be opened as per the date and time mentioned in the tender. Tenderers are allowed to be present at the time of opening of the tender. LIOC shall not be responsible for delays in tenders sent through post or courier, etc. Tender received late shall not be opened and shall be rejected outright.
- 7.17 The successful tenderer on being notified by Lanka IOC PLC of the acceptance of his tender within 10 Working days of such notification should pay the value of the accepted Tender Amount by demand draft drawn in favour of “Lanka IOC PLC” and make arrangements to remove the Scrap Materials in the present condition from Lanka IOC PLC, respective premises at their own expense within 6(SIX) Weeks.

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- 7.18 The successful Bidders shall adhere to the safety and security regulations of the Lanka IOC Plc in removing the materials from the premises of the Lanka IOC and any damage caused to the Lanka IOC property, equipment shall make good at their own expense.
- 7.19 The Bid Bond of the unsuccessful Bidders shall be released only after the tender is finalized. The bid bond of the successful bidders will be released only after the satisfactory removal of the items within the stipulated time period.
- 7.20 The Lanka IOC PLC does not bind itself to accept the highest or any tender or portion of it and has the sole discretion to reject any or all the tenders and further more reserves its sole right to sell or otherwise dispose materials which are not removed within the stipulated time period.

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8. TERMS & CONDITIONS – SAFETY (PART II)

Since the works have to be carried out in Petroleum storage and distribution establishment, the contractors should ensure that day to day operations, safety & security of the location are not affected in any way on the account of the work being carried out. In case of any damage to LIOC properties due to negligence on the part of the contractor or their workmen, the contractor will be held responsible and liquidated damages as asserted by the corporation would be recovered from them. When hot works are involved the following safety precautions have to be strictly observed before commencement of hot works. All hot work operations should be undertaken only after issue of hot work permit by Site Engineer on a day to day basis.

- a. It should be ensured that the tanks, containers, pipelines etc. where hot work is required are gas free and properly checked to this effect with explosive meters.
- b. It should be ensured that surrounding area is free of oil rags, spillages and other sources of ignition and the area cleaned and sprinkled with dry sand / earth. It should also be ensured that metallic trays filled with DCP are kept for collecting the welding arc / hot metal cutting.
- c. Hot work should commence only after positioning the portable fire extinguishers and sand / dry powder in readiness at site and hydrant system made available at the nearest point.
- d. Match boxes, lighters etc. used for hot work should be kept in the custody of supervisor.
- e. If hot work has to be carried out in a place close to storage tanks or any other facility under operation, it is necessary to provide a screen wall made of AC sheets to segregate the area to prevent the sparks traveling to the hazardous area.
- f. It should be ensured that no workmen carry matchboxes or any other source of ignition with them while entering the premises or inside the premises. After the hot work operation of the day, the following precautions should be taken.
 - Welding sets should be switched off and the power mains disconnected. If the connection is taken from temporary switchboard, the fuse carriers should be removed and handed over to the supervisor.
 - Gas cylinders and cutting sets should be properly closed and the equipment removed to a safe place.
 - The site of work should be examined to ensure that it is free from hot splatters and any other source of ignition.
 - All the workmen of the contractor should be moved out of the premises.
